Child development portrait

This portrait of the child's development will be completed twice a year, following up on the daily observations made by the childcare provider.

It will be completed as of May 1 and sent to parents no later than June 15 of each year as well as November 1 and sent to parents no later than December 15 of each year.

The summary of the observations will allow the childcare provider to orient her activities and improve her interventions in order to help the child in his development.

Collaboration and partnership with the parent are essential in order to allow the child to grow up in a harmonious and stimulating environment.

Let's not forget that each child is unique and we respect each other's pace.

At the parent's request, the caregiver makes herself available for a meeting if necessary. When the child leaves the daycare, all the portraits will be returned to the parents and the daycare service will keep a copy of them for 1 year.
